- Guide To Visiting Our Premises

From Tuesday 30th November 2021
it is a legal requirement
to wear a face covering
when on our premises.

Our staff will also be wearing
a face covering on our premises.



We respectfully ask you not to visit
W S Gayton & Son if you have:

- a new continuous cough—
this means coughing a lot
for more than an hour or
three coughing episodes in 24 hours
- a high temperature - if you are hot
to touch on your chest or back
- a loss of, or change in,
your normal sense of taste or smell

There are exemptions which permit
people to remove a face covering or
avoid wearing one –

These are:

- children under the age of 11 (Public Health England does not recommend face coverings for children under the age of 3 for health and safety reasons)
- people who cannot put on, wear or remove a face covering because of a physical or mental illness or impairment, or disability
- where putting on, wearing or removing a face covering will cause you severe distress
- if you are speaking to or providing assistance to someone who relies on lip reading, clear sound or facial expressions to communicate
- to avoid harm or injury, or the risk of harm or injury, to yourself or others including if it would negatively impact your ability to exercise or participate in a strenuous activity
- Police Officers and other emergency workers, given that this may interfere with their ability to serve the public
